Scholarship Criteria:

- The scholarship is awarded to a graduating high school senior pursuing a Bachelor's Degree in Architecture, Civil Engineering, Structural Engineering, or Construction Management
- Applicants must attend one the following accredited university or college full-time: Marquette University, Milwaukee School of Engineering, UW-Milwaukee, UW-Madison, UW-Platteville, or UW-Stout
- A member of the Fox River Valley Contractors Association must write a letter of recommendation for the applicant
- Scholarship recipient will make an oral and/or written presentation to the review committee on a yearly basis

Eligibility:

- Children of Fox River Valley Contractors Association member firms are eligible for this scholarship, regardless of where they live.
- Students from high schools in Brown, Fond du Lac, Manitowoc, Outagamie, Sheboygan, or Winnebago Counties are also eligible for this scholarship
